FALL HOME RENOVATION PROJECTS

Roof Work

Once all the leaves have fallen from the trees this autumn, cleaning up your gutters will prevent build-up of ice dams that can damage your roof in the winter—wash your gutters out with a hose or use a leaf blower. At the same time, check for holes or damages to your gutters and make sure they get repaired before the heavy snow damages them even more.

Also at this time take a good look at your roof—fix shingles that are curling and repair any loose flashing around the chimney. If you are unsure whether your roof will make it through another Alberta winter, call Time Line and we will be happy to assess your roof.

Window and Doors

GREEN HOME TIP

Improve Furnace Efficiency—Even if you have a top-of-the-line furnace, you can still improve it for further efficiency. The best way to do this is to ensure you keep your filters clean, close off rooms you do not use and make sure baseboard heaters & registers are clear. Check to see that all your ducts are sealed—by doing these small tasks you can reduce heat loss by twenty percent.
